Each week please *pick one* piece of learning that you and your child would like to do.

<p>Autumn walk Go on an autumn walk looking for signs of the seasons. What colour of leaves can you see?</p>	<p>Counting Practise counting objects and saying the total. For example, can you get 5 cars out? Count 10 Lego bricks. How many forks do we need on the dinner table?</p>	<p>We're going on a bear hunt Can you go on your own bear hunt? Where would you go? Do you have this story at home? Can you retell it?</p>
<p>2D shapes Go on a shape hunt at home or in your local area. Which 2D shape do you see?</p>	<p>Reading Go to the supermarket and look for print in the environment. For example, can you find the Weetabix or Frosties?</p>	<p>Library Visit your local library. Look at the books. You may be able to borrow some!</p>
<p>Being active A walk/scoot/ride at Virginia Water lake, a park or another destination.</p>	<p>Cooking Can you help mummy, daddy or an adult you know to make some food? For example a cake, smoothie, sandwich. Talk about the ingredients you use. Do you need to weigh them?</p>	<p>Christmas or Diwali Write your names in Christmas cards or Diwali cards. Can you write a gift list?</p>
<p>Each week please remember to;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • share your child's reading book and also tell them stories • go through their phoneme book and practise the sounds • TALK - about the day, likes and dislikes, what is going to happen at the weekend, family
