



ACCESS TO PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING

The school may be eligible to receive additional funding called Pupil Premium of up to £1320 per pupil based upon parents/carers who meet the criteria as detailed below.

This additional funding can have a real impact on your child through additional support and resources in class and in addition each child will also be eligible to attend an after school club funded by the school.

Does either parent receive any of the following:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Are either or both parents members of **HM Armed Forces** or receive a child pension from the MOD?

Has your child been **adopted** (e.g. from Local Authority Care)?

Has your child been **looked after** by Social Care for at least 1 day?

All we need to claim this funding is your name and national insurance number.
