



## A Guide to the School Day

<b>8am</b>	School opens for Pleiades Morning Club. Parking is available around the school on Crown Road, Trumps Green Avenue and Cabrera Avenue. Please park considerately around the school, avoiding driveways and the zig-zag markings. Please be aware that Surrey Police regularly patrol and parking tickets are issued to illegally parked vehicles. Please note that dogs are not allowed on school premises.
<b>Timings to be advised</b>	Usually, your child would be dropped off and collected from their classroom. However, due to the current Covid restrictions, we are operating a staggered start time with collection and drop off at pre-arranged school gates. Further information will follow as it becomes available.
<b>9.10am</b>	School gates are locked. Access is via the front gate buzzer system only.
<b>10.30 - 10.45am</b>	Break time. Children are allowed to eat a fruit snack.
<b>12.00 – 1.00pm</b>	Lunchtime. All infant school children are entitled to a free school meal or may bring a packed lunch if they prefer. School meals must be ordered using the Lunch Preference Form and give 1 week notice of a change in provision.
<b>Timings to be advised</b>	School finishes. Please collect your child from the designated collection point. Further information on your child's pick up time will follow as it becomes available.
<b>3 – 6pm</b>	Children registered with Pleiades Wrap Around Club will be collected from their classroom by a Pleiades staff member. This is an on-site provision. Parents can register their children directly through Pleiades website <a href="https://www.pleiadesleisure.com/">https://www.pleiadesleisure.com/</a>
	An After School Club timetable will run throughout the year for years 1 & 2. This will be made available for Reception children later in the year when they have settled into school life.
