Reception

Computing is not explicitly mentioned within the EYFS curriculum, however there are still many opportunities for the children to use technology to solve problems and produce creative outcomes i.e. Taking a photograph with a camera or tablet, playing games on the interactive board or tablet, exploring mechanical toys, using BeeBots and listening to music. Children are introduced to online safety and how to access technology within school safely. This is continuously reinforced throughout the year through PSHE and Safeguarding assemblies which teach the children about online safety.

Year 2

Information technology:

Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate, and retrieve digital content

Recognise that work can be shared between devices. Use a computer to view data in different ways.

Understand what personal information means

Understand personal information is unique to them

Understand that not everyone is trustworthy and identify characteriestics of people that are worthy of trust

Identify situations when a trusted adults help maybe needed

Understand our emotions and physical sensations can alert us to unsafe situations

The importance of checking with an adult before participating in an online environment

To be open with trusted adults about online experiences

Understand what pop ups and online purchases are and how to response to them safely.

Understand that not all websites are appropriate for children and we should always check with a trusted adult before going on a website

Understand that not everything we read is true on the internet

Understand we should only use age appropriate sites that our trusted adult has approved in order to avoid images that might upset us.

Understand we can't trust everyone online and how we can protect ourselves
