Iris was very delighted that it was parents evening this week as she explained "it is all about the teachers saying how good we are being", which of course they are.



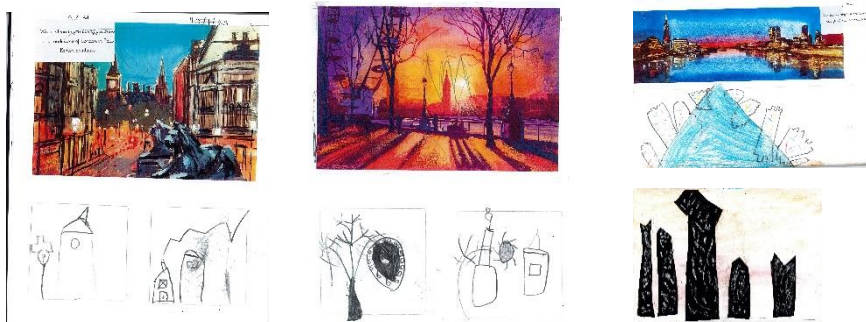
