PARKING ISSUES

We continue to have complaints from our parents and members of our community. We have been given this advice from Surrey Education Authority in conjunction with the Police. We hope you find it helpful.

"Reporting illegal and inconsiderate parking"

If you are aware of illegal or inconsiderate parking taking place and want to tell us about it, please send an email to SurreyParkingEnforcement@nslservices.co.uk with as much information as possible and we will send a patrol if there is one available in the area. If someone is found to be parking illegally, we can issue the vehicle with a penalty charge notice (parking fine). If the parking is just inconsiderate, we may not be able to take any action, but we can have a look."

"Dangerous and obstructive parking"

Where parking is dangerous or obstructive and there are no formal parking controls (such as yellow lines) in place, the police are the only authority that can take action against this. Examples of this could be parking close to a junction or on a bend or on a footway causing it to become blocked. In this case please report the problem to your local neighbourhood police team, on the non-emergency phone number 101."

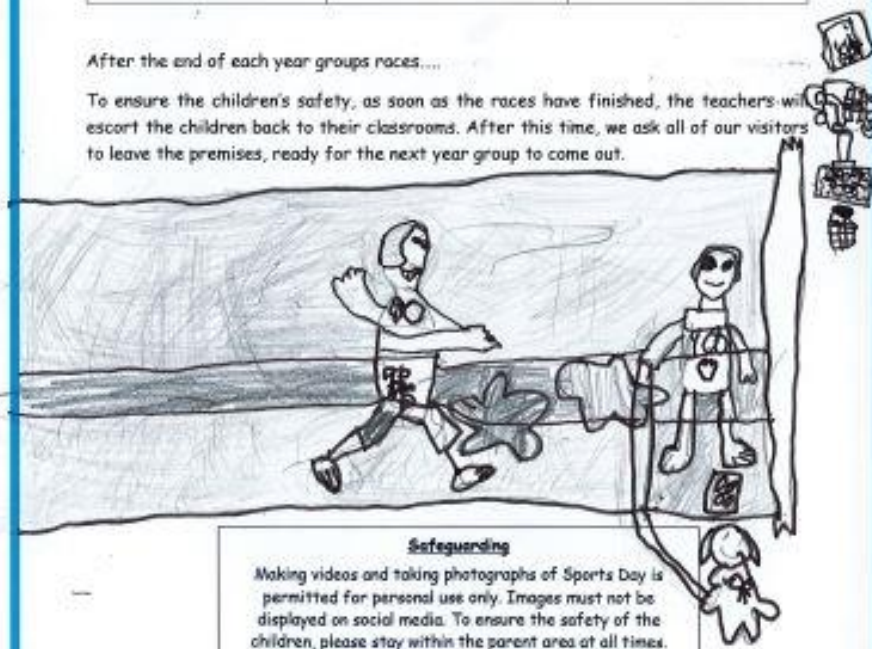
