Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you to all that attended our presentation on Tuesday.

We have had positive feedback on how informative it was as to the reasons we are vertically grouping Year 1 and Year 2. For clarity, this is not a choice and the decision will not be reversed. We have been instructed to do this by Surrey in order for the school to be financially sustainable.

We are hoping that this is a short-term structure and that pupil numbers will increase allowing us to return to a school of six classes. As I said in the meeting, the majority of our community is supportive and understanding but for those who are concerned or worried for their children's education and/or well-being, we ask that you trust our school and over time from September we know those worries will diminish. We ask you to be patient, as much of the organisation regarding the curriculum is taking place now and will continue over the Summer holidays.

For those who were unable to attend the meeting in person the slides are on our website and you have all received an email to say where the slides are.

Going forward, we will occasionally email with our requests for assistance whether that will be for small resources or for assistance with gardening or a simple mending job, etc. We are always grateful for your support as we know your efforts are voluntary and such gestures are never taken for granted.
