REMINDERS

Please may all the children bring suitable coats, hats, outdoor shoes/wellies etc in to school as we are frequently outside. We do not want anyone to be cold.

Please may we ask that children do not bring in precious things from home. This includes pencil cases and toys. The classrooms are such busy places and full of resources. It would be so easy for items to be mislaid or damaged which only leads to upset. We do provide everything that the children need. If your child has a specific need/reason to bring something in that can be agreed with the class teacher.

Please may we ask that fruit/healthy snacks provided are eatable in a short time frame. Snack time is included within playtimes and therefore if the children have an enormous snack, it reduces their playtime.

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ATTENDANCE

We understand that there are extenuating circumstances that mean occasionally the children are late for school. We monitor, with our Surrey Attendance Advice and Intervention Officer, where children are frequently late as it does have an impact on their learning and well being. Each morning we go straight into Phonics learning which is critical to children's reading experience and attainment. This then impacts on every curriculum area and also future success. Please wherever possible may you ensure your children arrive at school on time.
