ACHIEVEMENT ASSEMBLY

We had our first Achievement Assembly of the year yesterday which the children really look forward to. This is our fortnightly assembly where the children are awarded with words, certificates, pencils and badges. For those children who have improved presentation and handwriting they receive a rainbow pencil. The teachers select children from each class who have achieved in some way, this could be academic but equally in reference to our Proud Promises or Values and they come home with a certificate.

We also award STEP badges for (Saying thank you, excuse me and please). We have our Heart of the Community badges awarded for children who participate in an activity outside school that demonstrated kindness within the community. LEARNING LETTERS

Please see the weekly learning letters for information regarding the learning for the following week. We hope this helps you support your children throughout this year. On the website you will also find our Curriculum Jigsaws which set out the planned learning for the current term under each area of the curriculum. We hope you find this useful.

REASONABLE ADJUSTMENTS

We have expectations regarding learning, behaviour and policies and practices in school, which support the safe and calm learning environment where all have a right to be respected, be safe and learn and of course be happy. All our children and families may at times through various need and circumstances require some adjustments and we pride ourselves on working closely with you all if you have any needs or concerns.

SAFEGUARDING

For Safeguarding reasons, we need to always be very strict on opening gates and doors in order to ensure the safety of the children. Please may we ask that you help us with this by not holding gates and doors open for those who you do not recognise. Also, please do not use your gate codes for after school clubs during the school day and always ring the buzzer for the office to let you in. Additionally, please may you refrain from sharing with your children the gate codes.

Please ensure the children either do not wear their earrings on PE days or that they can remove them themselves and put them back in.

ITEMS IN SCHOOL

Please may we request that children do not bring in toys, stationary or special items into school. We, and most importantly the children, worry if they get lost, spoilt or go missing. We do make reasonable adjustments to this where children need for example a comforting toy or item but this needs to be agreed with the class teacher.

PUPIL PREMIUM

The school is eligible to receive additional funding, called the Pupil Premium grant, based upon parents/carers who meet certain criteria.

This additional funding can have a real impact on your child through additional support and resources in class and in addition, each child is also eligible for one or two free after school clubs and school trips.

Free school meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit - regardless of household earnings

Households may also be entitled to a meal if they:

- are in receipt of income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- receive the guarantee element of Pension Credit
- meet criteria set out in separate guidance for [families with no recourse to public funds](#)

Are either or both parents members of HM Armed Forces?
Has your child been adopted (e.g. from Local Authority Care)?

Has your child been looked after by Social Care for at least 1 day?

If you think you qualify and have not already let us know please speak to Mrs Sterling in the school office as soon as possible. All replies are treated in strict confidence.
