English

Reading

- Talk4Writing whole text and group reading.
- Begin to match graphemes to phonemes
- Link reading to own experiences.
- Make simple predictions.

Grammar/Spelling

- Begin to use capital letters and full stops and question marks.
- Reinforce alphabet knowledge.
- Capital letters for names and personal pronoun I

Speaking and listening

- Talk about houses and homes. Retelling familiar events and stories

Writing

- Forming short narrative sentences.
