PE and Sports Premium Funding

The government provides schools with funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer. The premium funding should be used to:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that schools already offer
- make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

Examples of how schools can use the funding are:

- hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers
- provide existing staff with training or resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively
- introduce new sports or activities and encourage more pupils to take up sport
- support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs and holiday clubs
- run sport competitions and sports activities with other schools
- improve resources and develop the outdoor learning environment to support the physical development opportunities for children
